


RAPID MAPPING AND ASSESSMENT

PERCENTAGE OF WOMEN'S POLITICAL REPRESENTATION AND THEIR ELECTABILITY IN THE FINAL LIST OF LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATES FOR 2014 ELECTIONS





Rapid mapping and assessment of the proportion of women's political representation and electability in the final list of legislative candidates for the 2014 elections is intended to:

•Provide insight on women's representation according to their voting area (dapil) and political party

Provide insight on the ranking of women legislative candidates from 1st to 5th rank with regard to their constituency and political party
Provide insight on opportunities for women's political participation for each political party based on candidate rankings in the respective constituency





















NUMBER OF LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL PARLIAMENT IN 2nd RANK BY SEX







NUMBER OF LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL PARLIAMENT IN 3rd RANK BY SEX









NUMBER OF LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATES FOR NATIONAL PARLIAMENT IN 4th RANK BY SEX






